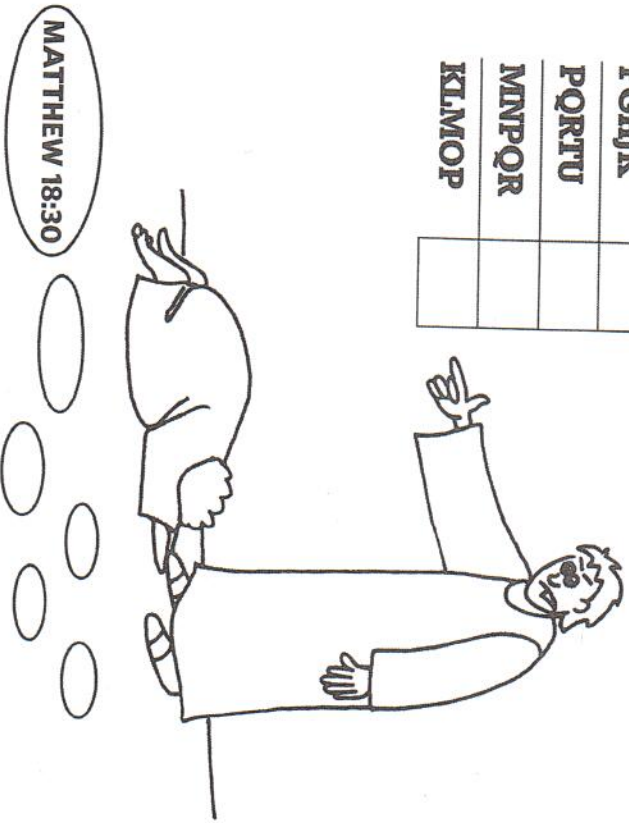
These two pictures might look the same but can you find
