

Sources of Hope:

The generosity of so many of our parishioners has helped to uplift our parish this year. The 2022 Diocesan Lenten Appeal supported outreach to seniors, infants and expectants mothers, and the sick and homebound. As the number of homeless rises in Western Pennsylvania, we will continue to need your help, prayers and support.

Thankfully our parish, and particularly our societies, are once again able to fundraise. This year, our Holy Name Society (helped by many members of our Christian Mothers Society) helped to make the homemade Ravioli and Sauce Sales a success.

We do have some future events on the calendar, so please consider participating.

The Christian Mothers Society is again hosting a Vendor Show (Saturday, Dec. 3, 2022) in the parish hall. For our youngsters in faith formation, Saint Nick will visit Sunday, Dec. 4, 2022, during their classes. And for the men of the parish, the Holy Name Society is hosting an Advent Retreat on Sunday, Dec. 4, 2022 (time to be announced - please check the parish bulletin or website). The weekend of Dec. 10-11, 2022, we will have a representative selling religious articles made of olive wood from the Holy Land. Our Holy Name Society will have their homemade raviolis and sauce for sale (date to be announced - please watch the parish bulletin or website).

I also call your attention to the National Eucharistic Revival, a three-year initiative to show as many people as possible what wonders the True Presence of Jesus can do to heal the heart and soul. Look for more information about adoration and reconciliation opportunities locally to help confront the hardships that we face in everyday life. The National Eucharistic Revival is a powerful, uplifting way to rise to these challenges.
