Feed My sheep.



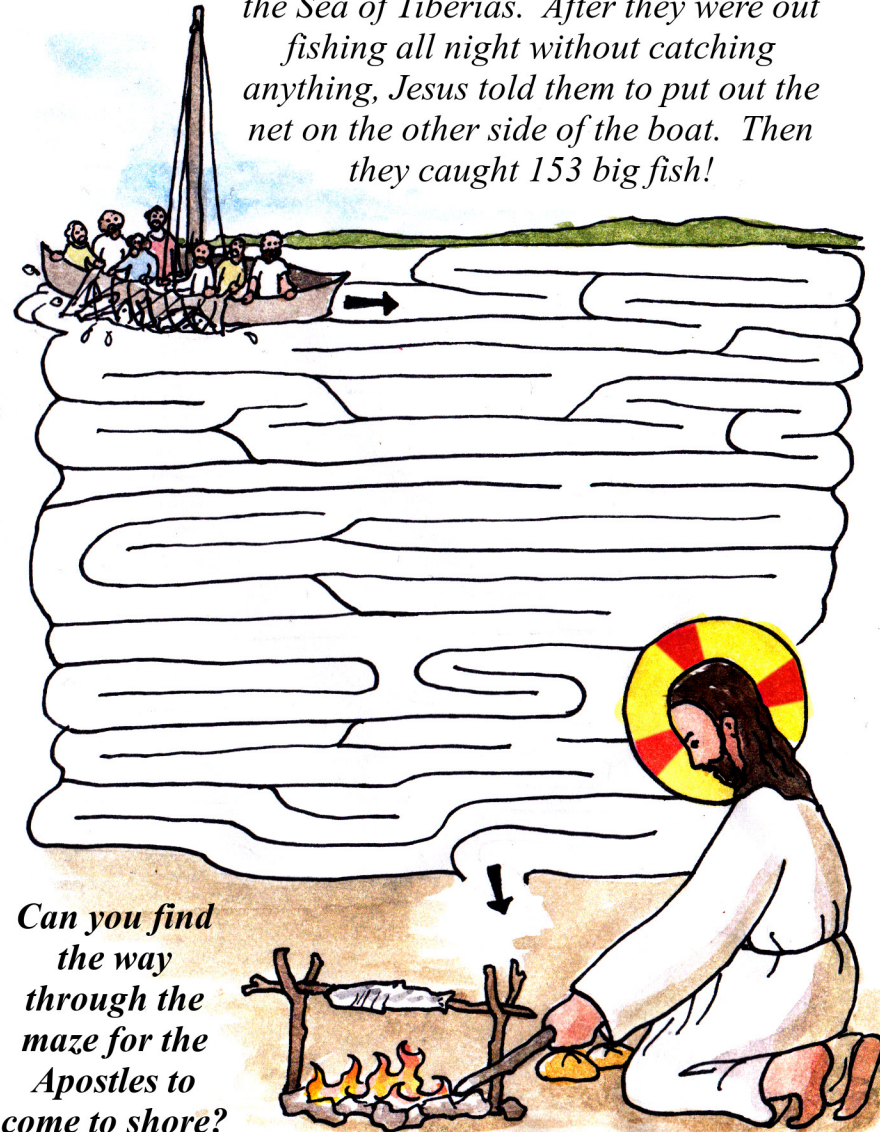

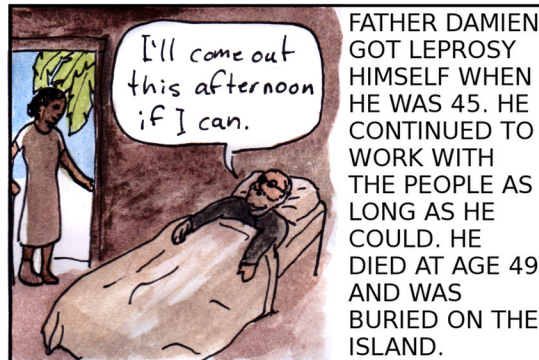
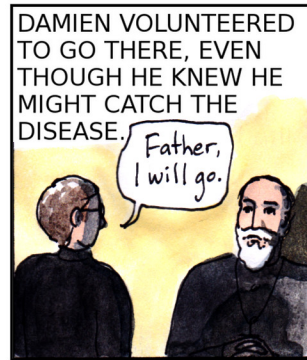
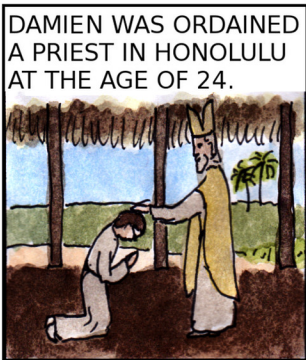
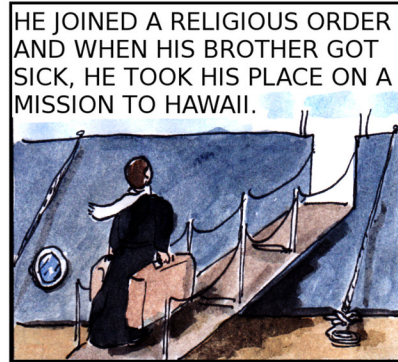
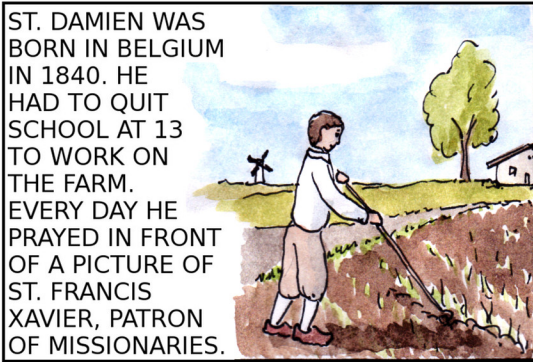
Third Sunday of Easter

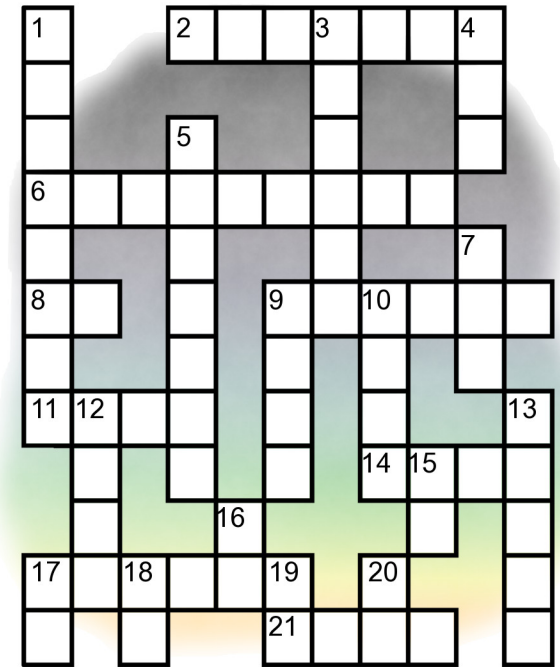
